DAY 3: SYDNEY - Blue Mountains and Australian Wildlife including Rides (Breakfast)

After breakfast at hotel, pick up at hotel lobby for full day **Blue Mountains and Australian Wildlife including Rides**. (S15+R)

Depart: 0815. Return: Approx. 1745

Pass by Homebush Bay, site of the 2000 Olympic Games. Climb into the mountains via the sleepy townships of Blaxland, Leura, Wentworth and Lawson. Discover Leura village – a delightful blend of groomed gardens and quaint shops. Enjoy free time to wander the streets of Leura. Stop at Echo Point and see the famous Three Sisters rock formation. Discover the aboriginal dreamtime legends of the mountains and Three Sisters. Follow the scenic Cliff Drive and enjoy breathtaking views of the Megalong Valley. See Katoomba – heart of the resort region within the Blue Mountains. Enjoy an easy walk and stroll along the boardwalk through the Rainforest. Grab a bite for lunch* or sit and enjoy the 360° views at Scenic World – the only view of the Three Sisters from your table! Ride the steepest incline Railway* in the world down to the lush and hidden valley. Enjoy amazing views over the Jamison Valley Take a ride on the recently unveiled Skyway*, a journey 370 metres above ancient ravines and dazzling waterfalls. Enjoy stunning views from Narrowneck and Cahill Lookouts. Enjoy an afternoon encounter at Featherdale Wildlife Park. Have your photo taken with a cuddly koala and get up close to our native wildlife. DAY 5: MELBOURNE (Breakfast)

Day 6: MELBOURNE (Breakfast)

After breakfast at hotel, pick up at hotel lobby for full day **Phillip Island Penguins & Wildlife**. (M10)
Depart: 1315 - Return Approx. 2130

Visit Warrook, a working cattle farm in the prosperous Gippsland region. Enjoy the opportunity to pat and feed kangaroos, wallabies and a host of farm animals. Journey along the coastal highway with French Island and Churchill Island in the distance. Cross the bridge at San Remo to enter Phillip Island - natural habitat for koalas, fur seals, Short-tailed shearwater, Little Penguins and more. Encounter koalas in their natural habitat at the Koala Conservation Centre. View the powerful southern coastline with its clean, sandy beaches and rocky shores. Stroll along elevated boardwalks and spot koalas in the trees.



Browse through the educational Phillip Island Visitors Information Centre. Enjoy interactive and educational displays in the Visitors Information Centre. Learn about the Little Penguins and life on this stunning island. Take your place in special viewing stands to watch the daily evening ritual. Watch the Little Penguins as they battle the surf and make their way to their dune burrows. Learn of the environmental and conservation methods that are initiated to ensure the remarkable wildlife and vulnerable geology of Phillip Island remains protected. See the Little Penguins up-close as they return to their nests to greet their young families. See the Little Penguin rockeries. Note : Nobbies viewing is seasonal and dependant on daylight hours.

DAY 7: MELBOURNE → KUALA LUMPUR (Breakfast)

After breakfast at hotel, free at own leisure until time for your airport transfers shuttle to Melbourne International Airport for your flight back home.
