### KAMAKURA WALKING & RICKSHAW RIDE TOUR (Lunch)

Visit Kamakura, a very popular tourist destination for its temples, shrines, historical monuments. Enjoy a superb view of Kamakura and the sea from Hasedera Temple before taking a short walk to the Great Buddha, the second largest Buddha statue in Japan. After lunch at a Japanese restaurant, take a rickshaw ride to Tsuruoka Hachimangu Shrine, the most important shrine in Kamakura. Walk along Wakamiya-oji, famous for the hundreds of cheery trees that line it, to the shrine. On the way home, stop by Komachi-dori's many arts and crafts shops and tea shops.

Board a local train on the Yokosuka Line to Kamakura.

#### **Enoden Line**

Take a train on the rustic Enoden Line to Hase.

#### **Hasedera Temple**

Proceed to Hasedera Temple with its famous statue of Kannon and also enjoy an excellent view of the town and Pacific Ocean.

#### **The Great Buddha**

Visit the Great Buddha, a bronze statue measuring 11.4 meters in height, at Kotokuin Temple.

#### **Lunch**

Enjoy a Japanese-style lunch at a local restaurant.

#### **Riding in a Rickshaw**

Take a rickshaw, a traditional kind of man-powered carriage, to Tsurugaoka Hachimangu

**Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine**

The features of Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine, the symbol of the first Shogun Minamoto, are its arched bridge, Genji and Heike ponds, huge ginkgo tree, and colorful main hall standing atop 62 stone steps.

Take a local train on the Yokosuka Line back to Tokyo.
