**DAY 1 KLIA → NARITA INT'L AIRPORT**

**(MOB)**

Assemble at KLIA, after check-in and departs for Tokyo, Japan.

**DAY 2 NARITA INT'L AIRPORT ⇄ HAKONE ⇄ MT FUJI AREA (LD)**

Morning we will be starting our day by driving to Hakone National Park where we will visit the **Owakudani Valley**, an area around a crater created during the last eruption of Mount Hakone some 3000 years ago. A short walking trail leads from the ropeway station into the volcanic zone to a number of steam vents and bubbling pools. Here you can purchase eggs, cooked in the naturally hot water, whose shells are blackened by the sulfur and which are said to prolong one's life by seven years. Continue **cruise on Lake Ashi**, it is a slender lake formed in the Hakone caldera some 400 thousand years ago. The inverted reflection of Mt Fuji viewed through the pine avenue in the southern shore is picturesquely scenic. Visit to **Peace Park** is to express the complaints of the Japanese war, pray for world peace. Peace Park is not meaningful and its quiet and elegant scenery is her charm. Park is covering 10,000 square meters, a typical Japanese garden architecture, lakes and small zoo giant fountain, planting trees and shrubs and flowers. Here also is a best place to view the Mt Fuji if weather permitted. Tonight, dressed in Yukata and enjoy a traditional Japanese dinner and not forgetting to relax yourself in one of the onsen (hot spring bath) within the hotel.

**Winter arrangement: Mt Fuji 5<sup>th</sup> Station will replace to Fuji ten Ski Resort where a best spot have winter fun during middle of December-end of February (ski equipments and snow activity will on own expenses).**

**DAY 3 MT FUJI AREA ⇄ TOKYO**

**(BLD)**

Morning we will be starting our day by explore to **5th station of Mt Fuji** to witness the spectacular panoramic view of the surrounding. Mt Fuji is the highest mountain in Japan and also the world famous symbol of Japan (if weather not permits will replace Fuji Visitor Center). Next, visit one of the most unique thatched roofed farmhouses - **Fuji Gassho-zukuri Village**. The village backup by Mt Fuji, you must not miss the beautiful scenery! If time permit, scroll around the **Gotemba Premium Outlets**, Japan's most popular outlet mall. The stores found at the Premium Outlets are the outlets of internationally known brands of fashion, sports, food, household goods and electronics, and range from everyday items to luxury goods. Overall it is a nice place for a day of shopping, with a lot of variety and reasonable prices.

**DAY 4 TOKYO ~ FREE AT LEISURE**

**(B)**

Morning you can start day tour to Tokyo Disneyland or following suggest attractions on your own. **Shibuya Park** opened in April 1979. The architect was Minoru Takeyama. TOKYU, the building's operator designed the building as a 'Fashion Community' containing small retail stores targeting the early-30s female consumer. TOKYU intended the store to compete with Seibu Department Stores, which was making inroads into the Shibuya area. Continue you can explore **Harajuku** which are young people dressed in a variety of styles including gothic Lolita, visual kei and Decora as well as COSPLAYS spend the day in Harajuku socializing. The fashion styles of these youths rarely conform to one particular style and are usually a mesh of many. Most young people gather on Jingu Bridge, which is a pedestrian bridge that connects Harajuku to the neighbouring Meiji Shrine area.

Next you can shop to **Omotesando Hills** in a series of Tokyo urban development by Mori Building. It occupies a two hundred and fifty meter stretch of omotesando, a famous shopping and (previously) residential road in Aoyama sometimes termed Tokyo's Champs-Elysees. It was designed by Tadao Ando and contains over 130 shops and 38 apartments. Lunch and dinner will be own expenses. You can enjoy the several of Japanese sushi, Ramen or others delicacies freely.

**DAY 5 TOKYO TOUR**

**(BLD)**

Morning we will be starting our day to Odaiba was born from reclaimed land in Tokyo Bay in the southeastern part of Tokyo. It attracts mostly young people as a new amusement spot in the city. We will pass by the **Rainbow Bridge** and **Tokyo Bay**. **Toyota Mega Web** is a showroom where you can be the first to experience races and new technologies. (Toyota Mega Web close on every Monday, it will replace to Venus Forte). Visit the most famous and oldest temple in Tokyo, **Asakusa Kannon Temple**. At the **Nakamise Shopping Street**, where colourful street filled with wide selection of souvenirs and traditional Japanese snacks. Explore the **Tokyo Sky Tree** will appear in the Narihira-bashi/Oshiage area of Sumida Ward, Tokyo in 2012. Boasting a height of 634m, the tower will be one of the World's tallest. Continue to Shinjuku is one of the famous shopping districts. **Shinjuku Kabukicho**, here can enjoy fun and shopping freely. Next, stop at **Ginza** the most famous upmarket shopping, dining and entertainment district, featuring numerous department stores, boutiques, art galleries, restaurants, night clubs and cafes. You will have approx 3 hours to scroll along shopping street and taking dinner also.

**Spring arrangement: Shinjuku Gyoen where a best spot for cheery blossom viewing during end of march-middle of April.**

**DAY 6 NARITA INT'L AIRPORT → KLIA**
