第六天 | 抵达 (机上用餐)

观光景点：

首尔

- **景福宫** - 是李朝 (1392~1910 年) 时期首尔的五大宫之一, 也是李氏王朝的正宫, 具有 500 年历史。景福宫是李朝的始祖——太祖李成桂 (1392~1398 年在位) 于 1395 年将原来高丽的首都迁移时建造的新王朝的宫殿。
- **北村韩屋村** - 拥有朝鲜时代瓦屋的北村从以前起就是众所皆知的两班贵族居住地区, 直至今日仍然完整保存了上流阶层的建筑形式。北村韩屋村位于景福宫, 昌德宫和宗庙间, 是与首尔一同走过 600 年历史岁月的住宅区。紧邻两大宫阙之间的传统韩屋聚落, 依然能看到像树枝般岔开的小巷弄, 更可观赏 600 年历史都市的迷人风景。如今这些建筑活用于传统文化体验馆或韩屋餐厅等, 能够间接感受朝鲜时代的氛围。
- **天空公园** - 位于首尔上岩洞, 上世纪 70-90 年代, 这里曾是首尔最贫瘠的地方, 经过生态环境改造, 如今已经是一个旅游景点。春季看花, 秋季看紫芒。
- **KAKAO FRIENDS 主题馆** - KAKAO FRIENDS 主题商店内卡通原型取自韩国国民软件 KAKAO TALK。KAKAO 有很多特色表情人物, 而且每个人物都有自己的名字, 像是可爱的小兔 MUZI、粉嫩的小桃 APEACH、大嘴 TUBE 等等。在江南区新装修开业的 Coex Mall 里的 KAKAO FRIENDS SHOP 主题店里, 可以和这些可爱的卡通人物来一次“亲密接触”。
- **松月洞童话村** - 小镇就像一个巨大的 3D 童话彩绘村, 以各国童话故事当作主题, 经过生态环境改造, 如今已经是一个旅游景点、白雪公主城堡、小鹿斑比等。

江源道

- **南怡岛** - 韩剧《冬季恋歌》男女堕入爱河的外景拍摄地。漫步于罗曼蒂克的林荫道。参观剧情介绍和不同的拍摄点。两排满满的水杉林道是南怡岛必拍景点。
- **昭阳江 Sky Walk** - 是设置在衣岩湖上的湖水观景台, 由透明玻璃所搭建, 步道长 156 公尺, 走在上方就像在湖水上漫步一样, 既浪漫又神奇。

京畿道

- **小法兰西** - 从建筑的风格看去, 别有一番地中海沿岸的风情, 与虎鸣山周围秀丽的风景相映衬, 宛如阿尔卑斯山麓的田园村庄, 这便是法国的文化村落小法兰西。小法兰西的设计概念为“花和星星, 以及小王子”。

Tourist Attractions:

SEOUL

- **Gyeongbok Palace** - Built in 1395, Gyeongbokgung Palace is also commonly referred to as the "Northern Palace" because it is the furthest north when compared to the neighboring palaces. Gyeongbokgung Palace is arguably the most beautiful and remains the grandest of all five palaces.
- **Bukchon Hanok Village** - Is home to hundreds of traditional houses, called hanok, that date back to the Joseon Dynasty. The name Bukchon, which literally translates to "northern village," came about as the neighborhood lies north of two significant Seoul landmarks, Cheonggyecheon Stream and Jongno. Today, many of these hanoks operate as cultural centers, guesthouses, restaurants and tea houses, providing visitors with an opportunity to experience, learn and immerse themselves in traditional Korean culture.
- **Haneul Park** - Is the most popular of the five parks situated in World Cup Park which was built to commemorate the 17th FIFA World Cup. Like its name Haneul, which means "sky" in Korean, the park is situated on the highest part of World Cup Park and offers breathtaking views of Seoul. Once a landfill, Haneul Park is an incredible example of ecological and urban regeneration. The annual Silver Grass Festival at Haneul Park is one of the city's most popular events. It is held each October when the silver grass is in bloom. Silver grass is also known as eulalia or pampas grass.
- **Kakao Friends Store** - offers a variety of products featuring the 8 popular Kakao Friends characters to the delight of fans and consumers everywhere. First emerging as mobile emoticon characters, Kakao Friends have gone on to set up stores offering over 2,000 products including toys, stationery, stickers, T-shirts, jewelry, etc.
- **Songwol-dong Fairytale Village** - A renovation project was brought upon to improve development of the village by painting and decorating classic fairy tales all around. There are many mural and fairy tale characters in the fairy tale world with the theme of world fairy tales.

GANGWON-DO

- **Nami Island** - the place was famous for its beautiful tree lined roads, the filming site of the popular Korean drama serial – "Winter Sonata".
- **Soyanggang Skywalk** - Is an observatory facility set up on Uiamho Lake. The walking path, comprised of transparent glass, is 156m long and offers a thrill to tourists as they feel they are walking over the lake.

GYEONGGI-DO

- **Pelite France** - Comprising traditional European-style houses, Petite France is also known as Le Petit Prince Village for its thematic design based on Saint-Exupery's timeless fable.
